SUPPLIER AGREEMENT #96

- I. A. In producing alloys which are subject to P&WC Engineering source approval and for which the supplier is an approved source, the supplier will obtain written permission from P&WC Engineering (using form F203) before making the first shipment incorporating any change in standard procedures or significant variation from standard procedures involving the following:
 - 1. Virgin material specifications.
 - 2. Change of established aim analysis.
 - 3. Melting equipment and procedures.
 - 4. Ingot size and design.

Note: any variation which has or may have an effect on the quality and/or properties of the material and/or ultimate product is a significant variation.

- B. The supplier will notify P&WC Materials Quality Assurance and the applicable forging source when abnormal or excessive cropping is required for reasons of quality.
- II. The supplier will maintain a list of heats certified to this supplier agreement for review by P&WC.
- III. The supplier will have written procedures and keep complete records of his formulation, melting and processing for each heat produced. Records and procedures will be kept available for P&WC review for a minimum of 10 years.
